Disaster Recovery and Rebuilding Grant Guidelines

Information

In 2019, the Disaster Recovery and Rebuilding guidelines were established for the purpose of providing monetary contributions to support disaster response, recovery and rebuilding grantmaking to eligible regional, community-based 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations or equivalents.

Grantmaking Process

At the declaration of a disaster by appropriate government officials, the Charity Foundation is authorized to review and recommend grants for eligible organizations that are providing recovery and/or rebuilding services to people impacted by the disaster. Recommended grants are approved by the Foundation President or entire committee.

Guidelines

Eligibility: An organization that is being considered for a Disaster Recovery and Rebuilding Grant must be acting as a community based 501(c)3 nonprofit organization or governmental unit and meets needs not filled by state, federal or other nonprofit agencies.
