The Assistance League of Las Vegas Receives ACBL Charity Foundation NABC \$5000 Donation

The Assistance League of Las Vegas, a nonprofit organization that provides clothing to school children in need, was selected as the recipient of a \$5000 donation from the ACBL Charity Foundation. At a check presentation on Friday, officials from the Assistance League (AL) were on hand to receive the funds from local and national members of the Charity Foundation.

Sylvie Courtemarsh, president of AL Las Vegas, explained that their organization provides brand new clothes to children in the Clark County school district. Selected by teachers and counselors, designated children are bused to AL's facility in Las Vegas to select and try on clothes.

The ACBL Charity Foundation provides \$5000 to host committees at each NABC, and the committees then select a local charity in each site to receive the donations. Local player Marie Allison helped guide the choice of AL for the Las Vegas tournament, along with NABC Charity Committee Chair Jennifer O'Neill, who is also treasurer for the national Charity Foundation
